

# School Uniform

The following regulations govern the school uniform.

**Normal Usage:** On all official or formal occasions, when travelling to and from School, when on excursions or when involved in any activity as detailed below. Blazers are optional in Terms 1 and 4 because of the hotter weather in these months. There will be some special occasions where students are required to wear blazers in these terms and these days will be communicated to students and parents. On occasion, the Principal may allow such must be sought in advance.

**Maintenance:** Students must be sent to the Uniform Shop to correct outstanding/non-compliant uniform.

## Summer

### Girls

- Hem to fall to the knees.
- Optional: Long navy trousers with long sleeved Redlands white shirt and short black socks.
- Redlands navy v-neck jumper as required.
- Yrs 3-6: polished, black, laced, leather, black-soled school shoes.
- Yrs K-2: black shoes with velcro bar fastenings or lace ups.
- White ankle length socks (not sports socks).
- School badge and House badge.
- Redlands School backpack.
- Redlands Sports bag (Yrs 3-6).
- School sun hat.
- Hair to be tied with navy accessories (elastics, ribbon, scrunchies). No hair dye is permitted.
- No jewellery is allowed other than one pair of plain gold or silver studs in earlobes. A wrist watch may be worn.
- No nail polish is allowed other than clear.
- Nails are to be clipped to a practical and safe length.
- No make-up is permitted.
- Hair accessories not to be worn on wrists.

### Boys

- Short sleeved Redlands blue shirt and grey socks.
- Redlands navy v-neck jumper as required.
- School tie.
- Yrs 3-6: polished, black, laced, leather, black-soled school shoes.
- Yrs K-2: black shoes with velcro bar fastenings or lace ups.
- Redlands School backpack.
- Redlands Sports bag (Yrs 3-6).
- No jewellery is allowed other than one pair of plain gold or silver studs in earlobe/s. A wrist watch may be worn.
- Hair to be cut so that it is away from the ears and collar and style must be neat and conservative; longer hair to be tied back.
- No hair dye is permitted.

## Winter

### Girls

- Redlands School skirt.
- High waisted knee length tights.
- Long sleeved white blouse with buttons.
- Grey tights or knee high white socks.
- Blazer to be worn to and from school (see Normal Usage above).
- Redlands navy v-neck jumper.
- Navy socks.
- All other items as for Summer uniform.

### Boys

- Yrs 3-6: Long sleeve Redlands blue shirt Long mid-grey Redlands trousers with short grey socks.
- Yrs K-2: Long sleeved Redlands blue shirt with short grey socks and Redlands trousers.
- Blazer to be worn to and from school (see Normal Usage above).
- All other items as for Summer uniform.

## Badges

### Girls

- School badge placed with the top of the badge in line with the top of the mitre and midway between the mitre and the edge of the blazer on left hand side.
- House badge is placed on the left hand side of the School badge in line with the bottom of the mitre.
- The badge of Office for Student Leaders is worn on the top left hand side of the blazer.

### Boys

- Yrs K-2: School badge placed on the left hand side of the lapel above the House badge.
- Yrs 3-6: School badge and the badge of Student Leaders of the School is placed on the left hand side of the lapel above the House badge.

## Other

- Scarves – Redlands scarf only.
- Raincoats – navy, grey or black.
- Umbrellas – navy or black.
- Gloves – navy.
- Redlands tracksuit and/or Redlands fleece.
- School sweaters may not be worn outside the school grounds.

## Performing Arts Uniform

### Drama

- Redlands Drama shirt.
- Plain black trousers or dance pants.
- Black, laced school shoes.

### Music

- Redlands Music shirt.
- Plain black trousers or long black skirt.
- Black, laced school shoes.

### Dance

- Redlands Dance singlet.
- Plain black trousers or dance pants.
- Black dance shoes.

## Non-School Uniform Days

- Days designated 'muft'.
- Study Camp and Vacation programs.
- Curriculum Camps.
- Casual clothes excursions (e.g. field work)
- International and other trips.
- Every student is responsible for an appropriate appearance in the school environment.
- Girls long hair is to be kept tidy and tied back.

### Acceptable Casual dress (for male and female students)

- Jeans or chinos.
- Shorts or skirts of a moderate length.
- Sturdy shoes in good condition that provide good support with non-slip soles. (e.g. leather shoes, bush walking shoes or similar closed-toe shoes, e.g. sports shoes)
- Plain or patterned T-shirts and shirts with sleeves.
- Hats and sunglasses are recommended for all students.

### Unacceptable Casual Attire

- Torn clothing or clothing with holes.
- Damaged sneakers or shoes, Ugg boots.
- Thongs or open footwear like flat sandals.
- Ill-fitting clothing (either too tight or too loose), no short shorts or skirts.
- T-shirts featuring offensive words, symbols or signs.
- Sheer or translucent fabrics without lining or suitable under garment.
- Midriff or skimpy tops.
- Singlets.

## Sports Uniform

Uniform items must be purchased from the Redlands Uniform Shop to ensure consistency of style and quality.

### Girls

- Redlands navy PE shirt.
- Sports shoes with non-marking soles.
- Redlands tracksuit and/or Redlands fleece.
- Redlands sports bag (yrs 3-6).
- No earrings.

### Boys

- Redlands navy shorts.
- Redlands navy PE shirt.
- Sports shoes with non-marking soles.
- Redlands tracksuit and/or Redlands fleece.
- Redlands sports bag (yrs 3-6).

Redlands fleeces may not be worn inside and outside the School unless with Sports uniform

# Representative Sports Uniform

**L(B) or**  
Season – Terms 2 and 3  
School AFL guernsey (loaned from the Sports Dept), navy socks with gold top, Football boots, mouth guard.

## Athletics / Cross Country

Season – Terms 2 and 3  
Redlands Athletics singlet (loaned from Sports Dept), navy bike pants (girls), Redlands sports shorts (girls and boys).

## Basketball (Mixed)

Season – Terms 1 and 4  
Redlands Basketball singlet hired through the Sports Dept. Basketball shorts (purchased through the Uniform Shop) or sports shorts and trainers.

## Basketball (Girls)

Season – Term 4  
Redlands Basketball singlet loaned through the Sports Dept. Basketball shorts (purchased through the Uniform Shop) or sports shorts and trainers.

## Football (Mixed)

Season – Terms 2 and 3  
Redlands Football jersey, Redlands Football shorts, navy socks with gold top, Football boots or trainers.

## Football (Girls)

Season – Term 1  
Redlands Football jersey, Redlands Football shorts or sports shorts, navy socks with gold top, Football boots or trainers.

## Gymnastics

IPSHA Carrara  
Redlands leotard (girls), Redlands Athletics singlet and sports shorts (boys), Redlands navy bike pants (girls).

## Hockey

Season – Term 2  
Redlands Sports shirt or Redlands Netball dress or shorts, navy socks with gold top, Hockey boots or trainers, shin pads, mouth guard.

Season – Terms 2 and 3  
Redlands Netball dress, white socks, Football boots.

Season – Term 3  
Redlands Rugby jersey, navy rugby shorts, Rugby socks (navy with gold top), Football boots.

## Snowsports

Season – Term 3  
Redlands polar fleece, Redlands tracksuit when travelling with the School, Ski helmet, Redlands Snowsports shell jacket and snowboard wrist guards are compulsory for all training and competitions.  
Redlands ski pants for training and competitions.

## Swimming

Redlands Swimming costume, Redlands Swimming cap, Redlands Swimming fins, Redlands Swimming goggles.

## Tennis

Season – Terms 1 and 4  
White Tennis polo, navy Redlands polo, Redlands navy, Redlands trackie, Redlands polar fleece.

## Touch Football

Season – Terms 1 and 4  
Touch Football singlet (loaned from Sports Dept), sports shorts or navy bike shorts, white sports socks, Football boots or trainers.

(winter) and polo (summer) sports uniforms.
