

School Uniform

The following regulations govern the wearing of school uniform at Redlands.

Normal Usage: On all official or formal occasions, when travelling away from School, when on excursion or when involved in any activity associated with the School, all students will wear school uniform below. Blazers are optional in Terms 1 and 4 because of the hotter weather in these months. There will be some special occasions where students will be required to wear blazers in these terms and these days will be communicated to students and parents. On occasion, the Principal may allow other arrangements, but such must be sought in advance.

Maintenance: Students may be sent to the uniform.

Summer

Girls

- Uniform dress with plain white collar.
- Hem to fall to top of knees.
- Optional: Long navy trousers with long sleeved Redlands white shirt and short black socks.
- Redlands navy v-neck jumper as required.
- Yrs 3–6: polished, black, laced, leather, black-soled school shoes.
- Yrs K–2: black shoes with velcro bar fastenings or lace ups.
- White ankle length socks (not sports socks).
- School badge and House badge.
- Redlands School backpack.
- Redlands sports bag (Yrs 3–6).
- School sun hat.
- Hair to be tied with navy accessories (elastics, ribbon, scrunchies). No hair dye is permitted.
- No jewellery is allowed other than a pair of plain gold or silver studs in earlobes. A wrist watch may be worn.
- No nail polish.
- Nails are to be clipped to a practical and safe length.
- No make-up is permitted.
- Hair accessories not to be worn on wrists.

Boys

- Mid-grey Redlands shorts with knee length grey socks.
- Short sleeved Redlands blue shirts.
- Redlands navy v-neck jumper as required.
- School tie.
- School badge and House badge.
- Yrs 3–6: polished, black, laced, leather, black-soled school shoes.
- Yrs K–2: black shoes with velcro bar fastenings or lace ups.
- Redlands School backpack.
- Redlands Sports bag (Yrs 3–6).
- School sun hat.
- No jewellery is allowed other than a single or a pair of plain gold or silver studs in earlobes. A wrist watch may be worn.
- Hair to be cut so that it is away from eyes and ears. Hair to be conservative; longer hair to be tied back neatly.

Non-School Uniform Days

- Days designated 'muft'.
- Study Camp and Vacation programs.
- Curriculum Camps.
- Casual excursions to a field work.
- International trips.
- Every student is responsible for presenting an appropriate appearance in the school environment.
- Girls are to be dressed tidily and neatly.

Acceptable (for male and female students)

- Jeans or chinos.
- Shorts or skirts of a moderate length.
- Sturdy shoes in good condition that provide good support with non-slip soles. (e.g. leather shoes, bush walking shoes or similar closed-toe shoes, e.g. sports shoes).
- Plain or patterned T-shirts and sleeves.
- Hats and sunscreen are recommended for all students.

Unacceptable

- Torn clothing or clothing with holes.
- Tights or leggings.
- Thongs or open footwear like flat sandals.
- Ill-fitting clothing (either too tight or too loose), no short shorts or skirts.
- T-shirts featuring offensive words, symbols or signs.
- Shoes or translucent suits without laces or straps.
- Midriff or skimpy tops.
- Singlets.

Sports Uniform

Uniform items must be purchased from the Redlands Uniform Shop to ensure consistency of style and quality.

Girls

- Redlands navy shorts.
- Redlands navy PE shirt.
- White socks.
- Redlands tracksuit and/or Redlands fleece.
- Redlands sun hat.
- No earrings allowed.

Boys

- Redlands navy shorts.
- Redlands navy PE shirt.
- White socks.
- Sports shoes with non-marking soles.
- Redlands sun hat.
- Redlands Sports bag (Yrs 3-6).
